### PowerElec 2026: Sustainability of Nigeria's Energy Transition Hinges on Institutional Readiness — Governor Adeleke



The sustainability of Nigeria's energy transition will not be decided by technology alone, but by the strength of institutions guiding the process, Governor Ademola Adeleke has said.

Mjmedia reports that this position was made clear at PowerElec Nigeria 2026, where Prof. Chimezie Obuzaku Igwe, speaking on behalf of the Ogun State Governor, stressed that institutional readiness is the real determinant of long-term success in the country's shift to clean and reliable energy.

According to the Governor, weak systems increase fiscal pressure, deepen reliance on emergency power generation and fuel subsidies, and discourage serious investment. He warned that energy unreliability goes beyond darkness and disruption, noting that blackouts erode public trust and obstruct how capital is poured in the economy.

Within this context, the Ogun State Government has focused on stabilisation rather than stop-gap solutions, prioritising systems that reduce waste, improve fuel recovery, and eliminate misplaced energy investments.
